Privacy Policy

The Braveheart Association needs to gather and use certain information about individuals to enable us to carry out our charitable activities.

The individuals we gather information on include our members, service users, partnership contacts, employees, volunteers and other stakeholders.

This notice outlines how this personal data will be collected, handled and stored to comply with Braveheart's data protection standards; the Data Protection Act (1998) and the General Data Protection Regulation (2018).

We are committed to safeguarding privacy and maintaining the security of all personal information. The purpose of this privacy notice is to explain what personal information we collect and how we may use it.

Purposes for which personal data is held and processed

Braveheart holds personal data for the following purposes:

1. To manage your membership and/or participation.
2. To manage your rights under our Constitution.
3. To manage your access to our services
4. To manage your access to our events, newsletter and communications.
5. Forwarding details to specific third party partners / other members only when requested by you (e.g. in relation to our services or events).
6. Sending you information we believe may be of interest to you.
7. Seeking information about you / your views. We will not sell your data, share it with other third parties without your permission and we promise to keep it safe and secure.

Your rights

You have the right to ask us not to contact you or withdraw your consent at any time.

You have the right to obtain details of the personal information we hold about you by making a subject access request in accordance with the DPA or GDPR.

You have the right to have your personal information rectified if it is inaccurate or incomplete. You have the right in specific circumstances to have your personal information deleted. You have the right in specific circumstances to restrict the processing of your personal information.
